

## **Sale Showground Rules and Equine Etiquette**

Sale and District Agricultural Society, as owner and manager of Sale Showground, Sale-Maffra Rd., Sale, considers the well-being of all persons visiting and/or using Sale Showgrounds to be of the utmost importance.

See general Rules and Regulations page 4.

The Society's Equine Etiquette guide is designed to enable you to contribute to the Society commitment toward ensuring personal safety through risk management initiatives aimed at, wherever practical, eliminating or reducing adverse behaviour, practices or procedures.

Failure by persons within Sale Showground to endeavour to comply with the Society's Equine Etiquette will be considered a breach of Showground rules and sufficient grounds to be asked to vacate the Showground.

### **Entering Showground and Parking:**

Drive in slowly! When parking, leave room around the nearest float where horses may be tied.

### **Moving on the Showground:**

Our Showground rule is always move at a walk outside the arena.

### **Arena Entry:**

Don't block the arena gate area.

### **Arena Etiquette:**

Keep within the designated warm-up area. Exit arena immediately if asked to do so.

### **Yards:**

Yards: A limited number of permanent yards are available within the Showgrounds for Showground events. An overnight yarding fee must be paid. This fee

- plus camping fee - also applies to travellers using yards for overnighting.

### **Tying up:**

Horses must not be tied to any Showground fencing whether of permanent or temporary construction. Tie only to your float.

### **Dogs:**

If you must bring a dog to our show, our rule is that dogs must be constrained on a lead at all time but also be prepared to have to lock your dog in your float. Never tie a dog to the outside of a vehicle or float.

### **Camping fees:**

All persons camping overnight anywhere within Sale Showgrounds must register on arrival with the resident Showground Managers (at cottage at far eastern end of Showground) and pay the nightly fee. There are no exceptions.

### **Public Caravan Park:**

Horse/float owners are prohibited from parking or camping within the designated Sale Showground Caravan Park precinct (the area east of the sealed roadway eastwards of the main arena) with exception only, and then only with Society permission, at significant events such as World Cup Showjumping.

### **Sewage Dump Point:**

A black-water sewage dump point located on the north side of the main arena (clearly marked with blue/white Campervan and Motorhome Club of Australia sign) must be used for emptying portable toilets.

### **Society policies compliance:**

All persons visiting or using Sale Showgrounds are required to comply with Sale and District Agricultural Society's policies, such policies including those relating to Risk Assessment, Emergency Reaction Procedures, Alcohol and Drugs, Bullying and Harassment, Incident Reporting etc

### ENTRIES CLOSE:

**FRIDAY OCTOBER 14<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

Late entries will be accepted at the Secretary's Office until October 21st with an additional charge of \$10. Entries will be accepted on the day Friday and Saturday at \$6 per class.

**HEIGHT:** Where height is stipulated, horses or ponies must be measured and an exhibit over or under the specified limit must be transferred to its correct class. R.A.S. and/or E.F.A. certificates will be accepted as proof of height along with those issued at Maffra Show.

**ALL COMPETITORS MUST WEAR APPROVED SAFETY HELMETS & FOOTWEAR IN COMPLIANCE WITH CURRENT AUSTRALIAN, EUROPEAN OR AMERICAN STANDARDS.**

**NOVICE Rider, Horse or Pony:** One which has never been placed first competing singly at any Agricultural and/or Pastoral show. Exhibitors must be prepared to sign a statutory declaration if called upon by the Chief Steward. Novice horses and ponies competing as such and winning any event shall be deemed to be a novice for the duration of the show.

**BREEDING YEAR** dates from 1<sup>st</sup> August.

**CAMPING** is permitted. Horses staying overnight must be confined within the security fenced area after 6.00 pm Friday. All temporary yards to be removed by 6.30 a.m. or entries may be cancelled. **DUE TO WORKSAFE REQUIREMENTS, NO POWER WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR CAMPERS AND NO ELECTRIC OR ROPE YARDS WILL BE PERMITTED.**

**STALLIONS** are not permitted in riding and hack classes.

**JUDGING TIMES:** The Committee reserves the right to alter judging times of events. Exhibitors are requested to note carefully any announcements made relative to program arrangements.

**DOG OWNERS NOTE:** All dogs which are not entered as exhibitors/competitors at show, are not covered by Show Society Insurance, and are therefore the liability of the owner for any accident which may occur on the Society's Grounds. Dogs must be tied up at all times.

**PARKING** A fenced in parking area is provided for horse floats and trucks. **Tying up of horses to the temporary fence is strictly prohibited. No parking is permitted in the Tabaret Car Park. All Competitors parking on grounds must comply with parking attendants or entries may be cancelled.**

**Electrified yards:** Portable electrified yards, yards comprising stakes and tape, rope, pennants or ribbons or any similar temporary construction, are not permitted within the Showgrounds.

**Steel portable yards:** Only portable yards of a steel construction and of a practical design to constrain horses within, are permitted at annual "Gippsland Show, Sale" or at any Society sanctioned horse event.

**GOOD HANDS COMPETITION** Presentation certificates will be presented to the first in each section; such certificate will entitle the holders to compete for the Good Hands Challenge Trophy at the Royal Agricultural Society's Show. Only Holders of qualifying certificates won during the proceeding 12 months will be eligible to compete for the Challenge Trophy at the Royal Melbourne Show. Competitors shall be judged solely on the riding ability. Mount, saddlery or costume will not be taken into account, but special attention will be paid to hands, general management and control of the horse or pony. Ordinary snaffle bit to be used. Single jointed, smooth and of one metal with or without cavesson noseband.
