2. **HEAVYWEIGHT** - Pen of 3 lambs 20-24 kg. Fat score 2-3 (6-15mm.) Premium 22 kg+, 8-13mm. fat at G.R.
3. **SINGLE TRADE PEN** - Single lamb. 17-20 kg. Fat score 2-3 (6.15mm.) Premium 18-17 kg., 8-13min. fat at G.R. *(May be nominated from section 1.)*
4. **SINGLE ELITE LAMB** - Over 22 kg. (May be nominated from section 2.)
5. **JUNIOR BREEDERS PEN OF 3.** First prize only.
6. **JUNIOR BREEDER SINGLE LAMB.** First prize only.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All lambs to be penned at Sale City yards by 9.30 a.m. Monday, October 24th, 2011
2. Lambs must be bred by the exhibitor from commercial flock ewes and must not show permanent teeth. Lambs with permanent teeth erupting will not be accepted.
3. Breed to be declared on entry form.
4. No Rams will be accepted.
5. Maximum of 4" of wool.
6. Entries may not be transferred from nominated class.
7. A maximum of 7 lambs per exhibitor for the competition or 2 entries in Section 3 & 4.
8. Junior Breeder (under 18 years) will compete in conjunction with section 1 to 4.
9. Juniors will then compete in section 5 and 6.
10. Judge's decision is final.
11. **No Entries Monday Morning**

Entries Close: Friday October 14th, 2011

JUDGING

Prizes aimed at highest average cents/kg. Carcass value. Carcass Judging will be on a grid system and eye muscle based on section specifications. Discounts for poor muscling, uneven fat distribution and unacceptable meat and fat colour may be incurred. Skin value will not be included. Hoof judging will be on weight, size and evenness of lambs and suitability to the class. A display evening will be held at Gordyn Abattoirs on Wednesday between 6 - 6.30pm, October 26th with presentations and discussion at the Prime Lamb BBQ at the Showgrounds at 6.45pm. Carcasses may be sold to Gordyn Abattoirs at current market value or retained by the owner. Cutting up of the carcasses will be done for a fee, subject to skin value.

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
