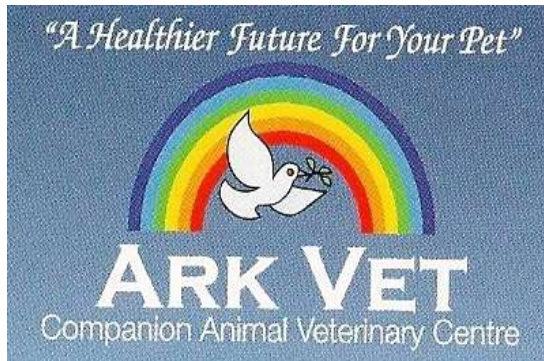

HANDLERS GUIDELINES

Best Kept - Dogs should have a clean and well brushed coat, clean eyes and ears and should be well fed, but not overweight. The kittens and cats awarded prizes in this section should have a shiny well brushed coat with no loose fur or tangles and clean eyes and ears. Birds should be in a clean cage, containing fresh drinking water. The bird should have clean, clear eyes and clean feathers. All other pets should be in a clean and suitably sized container and should look well cared for.

Best Mannered - Dogs are to be well behaved and suitably controlled by its owner.

Dog with the Wagglest Tail - Dog must be clean and obedient but, most importantly, it must wag its tail in a happy manner.

Prettiest Pet - The pet should be well kept and have a colourful and interesting coat, or fur, feathers or skin.

- D 1. Prettiest Female**
In this class, the judges will be looking at grooming and appearance, and all-around condition of the dogs.
- D 2. Most Handsome Male**
In this class, the judges will be looking at grooming and appearance, and all-around condition of the dogs.
- D 3. Childs Best Friend – 6 months to 12 years** (to be handled by a young person between 6 and 14 years of age)
- D 4. Most Obedient Dog**
The Judge will set simple tasks and be looking for the dog that happily obeys its owner.
- D 5. Best Rescued Dog**
Judges are looking for a happy dog in reasonable condition given the length of time the dog and the exhibitor have been together. Announcers may interview contestants and to hear the story of each dog's rescue.
- D 6. Best Mixed Breed**
- D 7. Best Pure Breed**
- D 8. Best Performer**
Does your dog know a trick? Sing a Song? Roll over and Play Dead? Good enough! Awards are given for crowd pleasing tricks with special attention for handlers and dogs who visibly enjoy working together.
- D 9. Best Toy /Small Dog**
- D 10. Best Medlum /Large Dog**

In all the 'Handler' classes, the Judge is looking for the person displaying showmanship along with consideration of their dog and other contestants.
